The Science team at TEMA are committed to ensuring your child's success in their GCSEs.

I am writing to let you know that your child has been selected to have bespoke intervention in science to support them in accessing the revision materials that we have provided for them to facilitate their independent study.

Students will be receiving a revision guide to ensure they have access to the core information that they need for their Edexcel science course.

To help with revision we have also provided a booklet to them that was received either during parents evening or in class. This booklet has the following things to help keep students motivated and to encourage them to study independently:
